- Edmonton was the first city in Canada to adopt a community league system and the Community League Movement is now officially 100 years old!
- More than half a billion dollars has been raised by volunteers for community league infrastructure. From spray parks and playgrounds to rinks and community halls, they have helped build Edmonton.
- Our league system is well known internationally as a model for community engagement that has had a profoundly positive effect on the quality of life for residents
